### **Guidelines for Posters**

- Size of poster will be a maximum of A0.
- At least 1 member of your team must attend the conference (Note that application must be made separately).
- The idea of the poster is that you present your work clearly and simply. It is useful to have headings such as introduction, outline of programme, results, conclusions.
- A poster should not have too much detail but is a snapshot of your work.
- If you want to prepare handouts with additional details this is acceptable.
- Please include contact details on your poster.
- An electronic copy (ideally PDF) of the completed poster should be sent to [jackie.sturt@kcl.ac.uk](mailto:jackie.sturt@kcl.ac.uk) **and** [ian.lucas@uwclub.net](mailto:ian.lucas@uwclub.net) by the 2nd May and will be available on the DEN website after the conference.
